As you begin to locate your backpacks and try on tennis shoes, we want to welcome you to the 2022-23 school year! Below are some important dates that we would like you to mark on your calendar as it applies to your family:

August 10 from 7am-5pm: GC-B Registration for all students PreK-6th grade in the school office. School supply list will be available. Also available on our website (gcbschools.org)

August 22 from 5:00-6:30pm: GC-B Family Picnic. Bring school supplies to drop off in your child(ren)'s classroom, say hello to their teacher, and eat dinner together on our front lawn! Bring lawn chairs and blankets.

August 23: FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL for Kindergarten-6th grade! Breakfast begins at 7:35am. Please enter through our daycare doors. All other students not participating in breakfast can wait on the sidewalks with school-provided adult supervision. Any student dropped off prior to 7:30am must wait outside or be on our daycare roster to be in the building.

August 23-24: 2 hour early outs each day at 1:00pm

August 25 at 6:00pm: Preschool Parent Night. Stop by your 3 or 4 year old preschooler's classroom for information for the coming year. A light snack will be provided.

September 7: FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL for preschool 3 year old preschool begins at 8am in Miss Ally's classroom. Please contact Jessica or Darlene if you would like to participate in breakfast. They will need to be clocked in for daycare. Our 4 year olds will have school supervision at 7:30am.
